⌚ How to Participate in Voting

- ◆ Election Day Voting : Vote at the **designated polling place in your resident registration area** on Election Day
- ◆ Early Voting : Vote at **any early voting polling place nationwide** during the early voting period (May 29(Fri) ~ May 30, 2026(Sat) 6:00AM ~ 6:00PM)
- ◆ What to Bring : An ID card with a photo issued by a government office or public institution, such as a resident registration card, driver's license, or passport

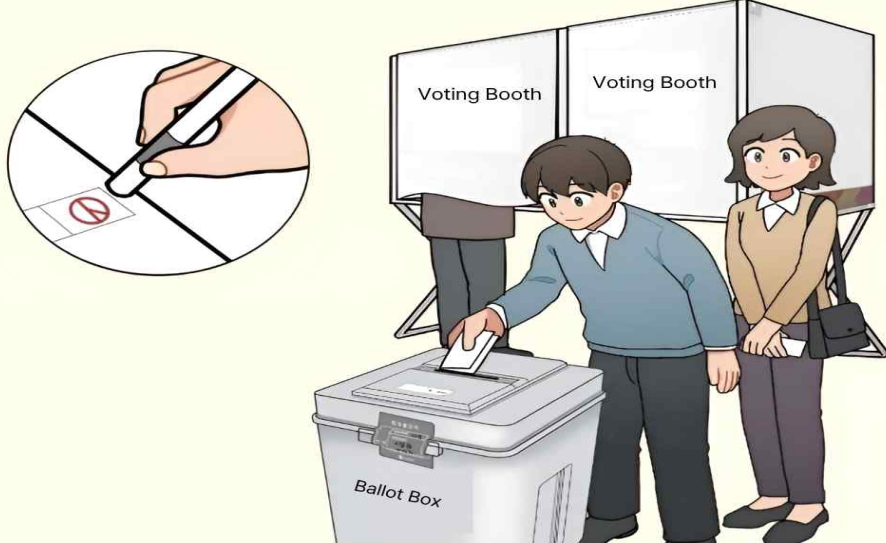

The 9th Nationwide Simultaneous Local Elections



■ Voting day is June 3, 2026(Wed)
6:00 AM ~ 6:00 PM.
If you are unable to vote on this day,
you may vote early.



■ The early voting period
(the first day to vote) is
May 29(Fri) ~ May 30, 2026 (Sat)
6:00 AM ~ 6:00 PM.



■ You must bring an identification card (resident
registration card, welfare card, driver's license, etc.).

Persons Eligible to Vote

Persons aged 18 or older (including those born on
June 4, 2008) who meet the following criteria

- ✓ Persons registered as residents in the
jurisdiction of the relevant local government
- ✓ Overseas nationals who have been listed on the
resident registration list for at least 3 months
continuously and are registered as residents in
the jurisdiction of the relevant local
government
- ✓ Foreign nationals who have passed 3 years
since acquiring permanent residency status
and are listed in the foreign national
registration ledger of the relevant local
government

※ Foreign nationals do not have the right to vote in
the by-elections for National Assembly members.

What to Bring When Voting

ID card

Identification documents issued by government offices
or public institutions that include the date of birth and
a photograph, such as Resident Registration Card,
Passport, Driver's License, Civil Servant ID, National
Veterans Registration Card, Disability Welfare Card,
National Technical Qualification Certificate (Human
Resources Development Service of Korea), Youth ID,
and Student ID from schools of all levels (including
private schools)

※ If you have a mobile ID among the above identification
documents, the mobile ID is also acceptable
(However, saved images, such as screen captures,
cannot be used.)

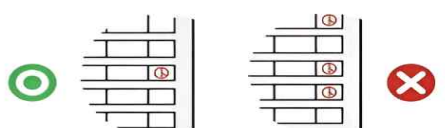
Things to Be Careful About When Marking the Ballot

marking tool.



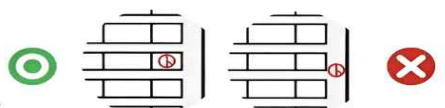
You must not

Guide to Filing Comprehensive Income Tax and Individual Local Income Tax in May

May is the month for filing and paying Comprehensive Income Tax and Individual Local Income Tax.
Please file safely and conveniently through non-face-to-face electronic filing.

- **Filing and Payment Period** : May 6(Wed) ~ June 1, 2026 (Mon)
- **Filing Methods**
 - ▷ Electronic Filing
 - PC : When filing through Hometax(www.hometax.go.kr) file in connection with Wetax.
 - Mobile : When filing through the Sontax app, file in connection with Wetax
 - ▷ In-Person Filing
 - Eligible Persons : Individuals aged 65 or older and persons with disabilities
 - Location : Individual Local Income Tax Assistance Counter, B1F, Namdong-gu Office

Save the environment and get paid back at 'Took!', our neighborhood's smart store-style junk shop, awaits you. We measure the weight of recyclable items piled up throughout your home using the kiosk located at 'Took!', and refund the equivalent value directly to your account.

- **Operating Hours** : Tuesday ~ Sunday (09:00 ~ 18:00) / Closed on Mondays and Public Holidays
- **How to Use** : Sort by Item ▶ Visit Store ▶ Kiosk Measurement ▶ Bank Account Refund
- **Accepted Items**
 - Basic Items : Bank Account Refund
 - Waste paper [boxes], books, clothes, transparent PET, cans (aluminum/iron), waste electrical wires, frying pans, pots, faucets, copper, stainless steel, empty bottles, small appliances
 - Sharing Items : Sharing with Neighbors
 - Wheelchairs, crutches, suitcases, air fryers, irons, blenders, kick scooters, bicycles (electric/manual), children's bicycles, etc.

Pre-Registration System for Preventing Missing Children, Mentally Disabled, and Dementia Patients

To prevent missing incidents of children and others and to find them early, personal information, photos, fingerprints, etc. are pre-registered for establishing a missing safety network.

- **What is Pre-registration?**
 - It is the advance registration of photos, fingerprints, and guardian information at the police to quickly find missing persons when they are reported missing.
- **Registration Targets** : Children, mentally disabled, dementia patients
 - ※ Children under 18 at the time of missing, intellectually disabled, autistic, mentally disabled persons, and dementia patients who are separated from their guardians due to abduction, inducement, abandonment, accident, runaway, or losing their way
- **How to Register**
 - You can register by visiting a nearby police substation (or patrol box) or police station. Guardians can also register directly through the Safety Dream website(www.safe182.go.kr) or the Safety Dream app.
 - ※ Missing Children Search Hotline: 182 (no area code required)
- **Required Documents**
 - When visiting, please bring a copy of the **Resident Registration Certificate**, guardian's ID, and a **Certificate of Disability** (only applicable if the child subject to registration is intellectually disabled, autistic, or mentally disabled)
 - ※ On-site registration is not possible without an ID or copy of the Resident Registration Certificate

Guide to Applying for Free Tap Water Quality Testing 「Incheon-style Water Care」

If you are curious about the quality of your tap water, apply right now!
A tap water quality inspector will visit your home to conduct a free water quality test and provide the results on-site.

- **Application Period** : Year-round
- **Inspection Method** : A 'tap water quality inspector' from the Namdongbu Waterworks Office of the Waterworks Headquarters visits homes and conducts same-day testing
- **Inspection Items** : 5 items (Turbidity, pH, Residual Chlorine, Iron, Copper)
 - ※ If any items exceed standards, a second free water quality inspection (13 items) will be conducted. Information on the Indoor Water Pipe Improvement Support Project will be provided to households requiring water supply environment improvements

Welfare

Dodam Dodam Toy World Namdong-gu Office Branch Information

We lend toys, books, and video materials suitable for the development of infants and young children.

• Eligible Users

- Families with children aged 5 or younger who are registered residents of Incheon or who work at a workplace located in Incheon
- Families with children aged 12 or younger classified as having a mental disability (Developmental – Intellectual/Autism Spectrum Disorder, Mental – Mental Disorder)
- Pregnant women, etc., who are registered residents of Incheon or work in Incheon

• Location : 1st Floor, Vehicle Registration Civil Affairs Office, Annex Building, Namdong-gu Office

• Annual Fee : ₩10,000 per year (₩2,000 for members from other branches)

- ※ Exemption: Families with 2 or more children, multicultural families, national merit recipients, low-income families, children with disabilities, families of adolescent parents, etc.

• Rental Method : Rental period is 14 days, available up to 6 times per month

- 11 items can be rented per member (2 toys, 5 books, 4 video materials)
- 1 additional toy for each additional infant/toddler child (maximum 4 toys)
- Pregnant women may only rent books and video materials until childbirth

• Operating Hours : Tuesday – Saturday (10:00 – 18:30), Lunch Break: 13:00 – 14:00 (Closed)

- ※ Closed: Sundays, Mondays, and Public Holidays

Information on National Cancer Screening and General Health Checkups for Medical Aid Recipients

We help medical aid recipients receive cancer screenings and health checkups free of charge.

• Program Period : Until December 2026

• Eligibility : Among Namdong-gu medical aid recipients, those born in even-numbered years

• Screening Cost : Free

• How to Apply

- National Health Insurance Service website(www.nhis.or.kr) → Health Moa → Find Screening Institution / Find Hospital → Search for nearby hospitals and clinics – Make a reservation and visit with your ID card

• Screening Items : General health checkup and cancer screening items differ depending on gender and age

- ※ At the end of the year, reservations may be difficult due to many examinees, so please receive your screening in advance.
- ※ If you receive screening for items other than the designated items, out-of-pocket expenses may occur.
(예: Examples: sedated endoscopy, polyp removal, etc.)
- ※ Screening items may differ by person, so please contact the hospital or clinic before making a reservation.

Incheon City Birth Policy “i+ Gilleodream” 2026 Incheon Expanded Hourly Childcare

This is Incheon’s expanded hourly childcare service, which can be reserved by the hour on weekdays and weekends when you have a sudden schedule or are worried about a childcare gap.

• What Is Incheon Expanded Hourly Childcare?

- It is the ‘i+Gireodream’ system operated by Incheon Metropolitan City, a welfare program where childcare services are utilized on an hourly basis at designated providers (such as daycare centers) on weekdays and weekends, and childcare fees are paid only for the hours used.

• Eligibility : Preschool children aged 6 months to 6 years residing in Incheon (Koreans and foreigners) (including 7-year-olds born in January or February)

- Children for whom at least one direct ascendant(parent or grandparent) of the childcare recipient resides in Incheon
- Children whose parent works in Incheon
 - ※ If grandparents reside in Incheon, a Resident Registration Certificate and Family Relations Certificate are required;
if parents work in Incheon, a Certificate of Employment must be submitted

• Operating Hours

- Weekdays (Monday ~ Friday): 07:30 ~ 21:00
- Weekends and Public Holidays: 09:00 ~ 18:00
 - ※ Closed on New Year's Day (January 1), Lunar New Year and Chuseok holidays, Children's Day, Buddha's Birthday, and Christmas
 - ※ Use is available in one-hour units, with no limit on total usage time(Changes may be made up to one hour before the end time)

• Location : Seochang Haetsal Green Daycare Center(032-473-2200)

- ※ 1 class is operated on weekdays and 2 classes on weekends, 3 children per class(mixed-age childcare)

• Fee : ₩2,000 per hour(Paid by parents after use, either in cash or by transfer to the daycare center account)

- ※ For usage from 07:30 to 08:00, the fee is ₩1,000.
- ※ If usage exceeds the reserved time by more than 10 minutes, a one-hour childcare fee will be charged

• How to Use : Apply online through the Parent Daum website(<https://bumo.iccic.or.kr/>)

- Advance Reservation : From 20:00 14 days prior to the date of use to 18:00 1 day prior
- Same-Day Reservation : Make a **phone reservation** with the relevant daycare center by 20:00 on the same day

2026 (Ministry of Education) Hourly Childcare Service Guide

Hourly childcare is a welfare system that allows families raising children at home to use childcare services by the hour on weekdays at designated service providers, such as daycare centers, and pay childcare fees only for the time used.

- **Eligibility**
 - Infants aged 6 to under 36 months who do not attend daycare centers, kindergartens, etc.
 - ※ Integrated Class : Infants aged 6 months to 2 years (born before December 31, 2023)
 - Recipients of Parental Benefits (cash) or Childcare Allowance
- **Operating Hours (Hourly Reservations)**
 - Independent Class: Weekdays (Monday~Friday)
09:00~18:00 (Single reservations not available between 12:00~13:00)
 - Integrated Class: Weekdays (Monday~Friday)
09:00~16:00
- **Fee** : ₩5,000 per hour
(Government subsidy ₩3,000 / Parent contribution ₩2,000)
 - ※ Support for 60 hours per month / **Support provided when paying with National Happiness Card**
- **How to Use** : Register the child on the Childcare Love website(www.childcare.go.kr)
