Crime Prevention Guide for Foreigners

How to Report a Crime

You can make a 112 report using a mobile phone (video call available), landline, or public phone. When using a public phone for emergency calls (red emergency call button + 112), it's possible even without coins, and it can be used for other emergency situations, not just crimes.

※ When foreigners call 112, crime (damage) reports are accepted through a three-party interpretation service (police officer, interpreter, and reporter)

If phone calls are difficult, reports can be made via the "112 Emergency Reporting App" or text message.



Tips for Reporting a Crime



If you witness a crime or are victimized, report it to 112 to receive prompt assistance from the police.

When reporting, please provide your current location and situation, detail when, where, and how you were victimized, and clearly describe the perpetrator's appearance, characteristics, belongings, number of people, escape direction, and mode of transportation.



To secure evidence, please preserve the disturbed crime scene until police officers arrive, and cooperate with officers as they examine the scene.

Interpretation services are available for crime (damage) reports and civil complaint consultations for foreigners.

Interpretation Services

Crimes Easily Committed Unknowingly



Forming, joining, or participating in a group for the purpose of committing crimes such as assault or intimidation is subject to more severe punishment.

Gambling for money is prohibited, and providing a gambling venue is also subject to the same severe punishment as gambling.



Taking items that appear to be ownerless can lead to punishment for theft or embezzlement of lost property.

Overseas remittance acts through individual transactions without going through financial institutions are strictly punished.



Foreigners aged 17 and over must carry their passports and alien registration cards at all times. Violations are subject to fines (up to 1 million won).

Penalties such as fines or administrative fines may also be imposed for violations of basic order, so be careful.

Do not indiscriminately discard cigarette butts, gum, or trash.

Do not spit in public places or smoke in non-smoking areas.

Motorcycle drivers and passengers must wear safety helmets and use overpasses or crosswalks when crossing the road.

2026 Support for Purchasing Household Food Waste Reducers

Namdong-gu will implement a project in 2026 to provide a subsidy (up to 300,000 won) covering half of the purchase price of household food waste reducers that have obtained relevant certifications for residents residing in Namdong-gu.

- **Eligibility** : Households with installed household reducers among residents in the district (1 reducer per household)
 - ※ Limited to general households (businesses are excluded from support)
- **Support Amount** : 50% of the reducer's purchase price (up to 300,000 won)
- **Application Period**
 - Detached houses: January 26, 2026, until budget exhaustion (first-come, first-served)
 - Apartment complexes: February 2, 2026, until budget exhaustion (first-come, first-served)
 - ※ Due to changes in Incheon Metropolitan City's support policy, **detached houses will receive advance support for one week**
- **Support Details**
 - Subsidies can be provided when purchasing household food waste reducers that have obtained at least one quality certifications among K-Mark, environmental labeling, group standards, or Q-Mark, using methods such as drying (grinding) or microbial fermentation
 - Sewage Act certified **kitchen waste disposers are not eligible for subsidies**

 - Purchase of reducer and submission of subsidy application form → Notification and payment of subsidy decision

2026 Guide to Subsidies for Apartment Buildings

Provide a portion of the costs necessary for the maintenance of common facilities in old apartment complexes that have been completed for more than 10 years.

- **Application Period** : Feb 2(Mon) ~ Mar 6(Fri), 2026
- **Application Method** : In-person application
(Apartment Housing Division, 2nd floor, Namdong-gu Office)
- **Eligibility and Amount**
 - Maintenance and management of public facilities (rooftop waterproofing, road paving within the complex, etc.) : Up to 50% of the total project cost
 - Repair of disaster-related facilities (repair/removal of hazardous tiles, hazardous fences, etc.) : 100% of costs up to 7 million won + up to 50% of amounts exceeding 7 million won
 - Maximum support limit per complex : 30 million won
- **Required Documents** : Application form, project plan, on-site photos, meeting minutes and photos, drawings, two copies of quotations, consent from at least 2/3 of the owners, bankbook copy, etc.
 - ※ The application form must be submitted directly by the complex representative, not by construction-related personnel
 - ※ Application forms can be downloaded from the Namdong-gu website or obtained in person at the Apartment Housing Division on the 2nd floor of Namdong-gu Office.

2026 Guide to Support Project for Improving Working Environment for Apartment Management Workers

We will partially support the costs of improving the working environment (workspaces and rest areas) of management workers in apartment complexes.

- **Application Period** : Feb 2(Mon) ~ Mar 6(Fri), 2026
- **Application Method** : In-person application
(Apartment Housing Division, 2nd floor, Namdong-gu Office)
- **Support Amount** : Up to 70% of the total project cost
- **Eligibility**
 - Building equipment installation : Air conditioning and heating systems, ventilation systems, dehumidifiers, etc.
 - Environmental improvement work : Flooring, wallpapering, etc.
 - Equipment support : Sofas, tables, beds, cabinets, etc.
 - Moving underground rest areas to above-ground installation
- **Required Documents** : Application form, project plan, on-site photos, meeting minutes and photos, drawings, two copies of quotations, bankbook copy, etc.

Unmanned Women's Safe Delivery Box Service Guide

The Unmanned Women's Safe Delivery Box was installed to prevent crimes impersonating delivery personnel, allowing all district residents to safely and conveniently receive parcels.

- **Eligibility** : All Namdong-gu residents
- **Installation Locations** : 11 locations within the district(can be checked on the "Ansim In" app)
- **Operating Hours** : 365 days a year, 24 hours
- **Usage Fee** : Free for 48 hours (after 48 hours, a storage fee of 1,000 won per day will be charged)
- **Usage Procedure**



※(Caution!!) Do not store dangerous or perishable items

- ① When ordering an item, be sure to indicate "Unmanned Delivery Box Address + Unmanned Delivery Box" and your mobile phone number.
 - ② Receive SMS with arrival notice and authentication code
- ※ If you do not receive a storage SMS, contact Customer Service (☎ 1600-5136, 08:00-22:00)
- ③ Receive the item after recipient authentication.

Village Housing Management Office Home Repair Support Project Guide

We provide home repair support to improve old houses in low-rise residential areas and enhance living standards.

- **Application Period** : January 21, 2026 (Wed) ~ February 13, 2026 (Fri)
- **Application Method** : Apply at the administrative welfare center
- **Support target**
 - ① Seniors aged 65 or older, elderly living alone
 - ② Persons with disabilities
 - ③ National merit recipients (Disability grade 1 to 7)
 - ④ Veterans compensation recipients (Grade 1 to 7)
 - ⑤ People injured in the May 18 Democratic Movement (Body disability level 1 to 14)
 - ⑥ Patients with Agent Orange aftereffects (moderate disability or higher)
 - ⑦ Single-parent families
 - ⑧ Housing benefit recipients and low-income households (below 50% of median income), near-low-income households (below 60% of median income)
- ※ Applicants from categories 1-7 are eligible only if their income is below 70% of the median.
- ※ "Median income" refers to the "standard median income" as defined in Article 2, Paragraph 11 of the 「National Basic Living Security Act」.
- ※ For tenant home repair support, a "mutual agreement form" signed by the landlord must be submitted.

• Exclusions

- Individual houses and houses with individual household prices exceeding 600 million won.
- Unauthorized or illegal buildings listed as violations in the building register.
- Houses that received or are scheduled to receive repair support under other laws/programs within the past 3 years (for the same part).
- Recipients of repair and maintenance benefits under the 「Housing Benefit Act」.

• Scope of Support

- Support Items: Wallpapering, flooring, sink, electricity, boiler, waterproofing, plumbing, etc.
- Support Amount: Up to 5 million won per household.

2026 Angel Support Fund Payment

This is an Incheon Metropolitan City policy to support all age groups of infants and toddlers (children aged 1 to 7 born after January 1, 2023) to overcome the extremely low birth rate.

- **Eligibility** : Children aged 1 to 7 born after January 1, 2023
 - ※ 2026 applicants: Children born between 2023 and 2025.
- **Support Amount**: 1.2 million won per year (paid as Incheon E-eum local currency points)
- **Eligibility Requirements**
 - Children who reside in Incheon City continuously for at least one year with their father or mother registered as residents, based on the child's birthday
- **Applicant** : The child's father or mother
- **Application Period** : Within 120 days from the child's birthday
 - ※ After the first application, payments are automatically made every year
- **Usage Period** : 12 months from the payment date (point generation date)
 - Cannot be used after the usage period expires

- **Operation Method** : Use the "Mally" app for 20 minutes a day, Monday to Friday, for dementia prevention activities
- **Project Content**
 - Operate various cognitive training programs using a smart application
 - Conduct emotion regulation activities to prevent depression in the elderly
 - Operate exercise programs that help prevent dementia like aerobics, strength training, fine motor skills, stretching
 - Provide self-diagnosis services for depression and geriatric diseases to easily check one's current condition
